## Bury St Angels

Have you seen how some villages have a 'scarecrow' competition? Well, let's go upmarket a bit. In Bury St Edmunds we are having an 'angel' competition.

### The Rules

The rules are simple. Make an angel, between 1 metre and 2 metres high (approx 3ft - 6ft). Display your angel in your garden or on your property so that it can be seen from a public space (for example roads and pavements).

### The Dates

Your angel should be on display for two weeks from Sunday March 14th. The judging team will travel around and look at all the angels on Saturday 20th and Sunday 21st of March (the first day of Spring).

### Entry

You can enter as an individual, team, pub, church, school, Brownies, youth club - anyone. The entry fee is £5.

### Prizes

The modest entry fee (£5) will be used to pay for advertising, and for a prize fund.

Please ensure that your entry is well secured and if it does fall, it must fall onto your property and not be overhanging a public space.
